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WELCOME TO CHALLENGE WALK MS: 2014

It is an experience like no other. This guide will provide some great tips for fundraising, help you stay motivated and get your team organized.

DIRECTIONS:

From Salisbury and Points South

Take 50 West toward Easton. Follow 50 West for approximately 43 miles. The Comfort Inn Easton will be on your right.

From The West (DC, Baltimore, Annapolis)

Travel East across the Chesapeake Bay Bridge on Rt. 50/Rt. 301. Take exit US 50-E toward Ocean City and continue on 50-E for approximately 18 miles. The Comfort Inn Easton will be on your left.

From the North (Philadelphia, Wilmington, New York)

Follow I-95 South, take exit 4A for DE-7 S toward DE-1 S/Christiana Mall Rd. Keep right at the fork and merge onto DE-1 S/DE-7 S, continue to follow DE-1 S. Then merge onto US-13 S, continuing onto DE-1 S. Then take exit 136 for DE-299 toward US-13/Odessa Middletown. Turn right onto DE-299 W/Middletown Odessa Rd, continue to follow DE-299 W. Turn left onto US-301 S/Middletown Warwick Rd, continue to follow US-301 S. After entering Maryland, take the MD-213 exit toward Wye Mills/Centreville. Turn left onto MD-213 S/Centreville Rd. The turn left onto US-50 E/Ocean Gateway, the Comfort Inn Easton will be on your left.

From the South (Norfolk, Virginia Beach)

Take the Interstate 264 E ramp to VA Beach. After approximately 4 miles take the exit on the left onto I-64 W toward Richmond. Then take exit 282 to merge onto US-13 N/Northampton Blvd toward Chesapeake Bay/ Bridge-Tunnel, continue to follow US-13 N for approximately 128 miles. As you enter Maryland, continue onto US-50 W/Salisbury Bypass for approximately 50 miles, the Comfort Inn Easton will be on your right.

From Northern Delaware

Take 301 south until you reach Centreville. Turn left on Rt. 213 South which will take you to RT 50. Turn left at the light to get on RT 50 East. The Comfort Inn Easton will be on your left.

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TEAM CAPTAIN DUTIES

Your role will be to serve as a leader to your members. Throughout the season, the Challenge Walk staff will contact you regarding important information, recruitment and fundraising challenges, prizes, rewards and day-of details. As a team captain and friend, your team members will be more likely to read information that comes from you and it is important that all participants receive the most current and upto-date information.

Of all Challenge Walk participants, 75% are part of a team. Enhance your Challenge Walk experience by sharing it with your friends, family and co-workers. We know that leading a team may seem like a difficult challenge, but this guide provides useful information and helpful tips that will equip you to be a great team captain!

BENEFITS OF BEING ON A TEAM

Team participation creates great community visibility for a company or organization and provides participants a healthy, community-conscious, fun social outing.

RECRUIT YOUR TEAM

BEGIN WITH PEOPLE YOU KNOW

Spread the word to friends, family and co-workers and encourage them to join you! There is no limit to the number of team members one team can include; the more, the merrier. If you are a returning team captain, start with your team roster from last year, which can be provided to you by the Challenge Walk staff. Encourage team members to recruit at least one family member, friend or colleague to grow your team!

HOST A RECRUITMENT EVENT

This can be a happy hour or an informal lunch in your office. Ask your team members to invite family, friends and co-workers. Challenge Walk rack cards and posters can be used at your office or businesses to spread the word about Challenge Walk and your team.

GET YOUR COMPANY TO ENDORSE YOUR TEAM

Ask your company to support your team. You can spread the word by highlighting your team in the company newsletter or by posting Challenge Walk materials around the office. FUNDRAISING

SET YOUR FUNDRAISING GOAL

Communicate your goal with your team often so that everyone is aware of your progress and important information regarding fundraising challenges, deadlines and prize information. Remind team members that they must raise a minimum of \$500, so use that as a starting point at which to set your fundraising goals.

ADD UP YOUR CENTS

Place an extra change jar at your home, office and local businesses for spare change. You'll be surprised at how quickly those extra cents add up!

FUNDRAISE WITH YOUR TEAM

Plan a team fundraising event to reach your goal! Host a happy hour, get together or dinner party for your team and guests. With a small charge to participate, you'll be able to fundraise while you socialize! You can also plan a raffle or silent auction by asking local businesses to donate items, gifts or gift certificates for you to raffle or auction. Some ideas are event tickets, movie tickets, hotel stays, gift certificates, dinner, artwork and jewelry. Don't be afraid to get creative! In addition, you can submit the information about your event to us and we will add it to our fundraising events calendar, which is visible to all National MS Society members.

DON'T FORGET MATCHING GIFTS

To increase your team's fundraising dollars, contact your company's human resources department to find out about their matching gift policy. They will give you instructions on how to submit the matching gift. Be sure to remind your team members and donors about matching gifts as well. FUNDRAISING WITH TECHNOLOGY

Everyone who registers for Challenge Walk gets a participant center, the online hub for managing online fundraising.

HOW IT WORKS

From the Participant Center, you can edit your Personal Page, e-mail donors, manage your campaign and for team captains, follow your team's progress. To get to your Participant Center, log in to your Challenge Walk MS event, login to your account with your username and password and click on Participant Center where you will be prompted to:

UPDATE YOUR PERSONAL PAGE

It's easy to change the layout, story and upload pictures to your Personal Page. Make it about you and your friends and family will make generous donations! You can even keep a blog on your Personal Page.

MANAGE YOUR TEAM

Email the entire team at once, track their progress, set your team's goal so everyone can see and support it, download your team roster, encourage team members to use their online personal page and create incentives for them to fundraise online.

REQUEST DONATIONS THROUGH EMAIL

You can easily import contacts into your Address Book from other e-mail applications such as Microsoft Outlook, AOL or Yahoo! Or add them manually. In just a few clicks, select and send an appeal for support or a thank-you. Use a pre-written e-mail or write your own.

FUNDRAISE ONLINE

- Track your individual, ongoing fundraising progress.
- Update your fundraising goal.
- View reports on your team members' contributions.
- Send follow-up messages and thank you e-mails to your supporters.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW MUCH SHOULD TEAM MEMBERS RAISE?

To participate in Challenge Walk MS, participants must raise a minimum of \$500. The money raised funds national research, chapter programs and public and professional education.

CAN MY TEAM HAND IN DONATIONS TOGETHER?

Each team member must register individually, however, teams can fundraise together and distribute the donations among team members using a Donation Distribution form. HOW DO I ACCESS MY TEAM PHOTO?

WHAT IS MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS?

Multiple sclerosis interrupts the flow of information between the brain and the body and it stops people from moving. Every hour in the United States someone is newly diagnosed with MS -- an unpredictable, often disabling disease of the central nervous system. Symptoms range from numbness and tingling to blindness and paralysis. The progress, severity and specific symptoms of MS in any one person cannot yet be predicted, but advances in research and treatment are moving us closer to a world free of MS. Most people with MS are diagnosed between the ages of 20 and 50, with more than twice as many women as men being diagnosed with the disease. MS affects more than 400,000 people in the U.S. and 2.3 million worldwide.

Early and ongoing treatment with an FDA-approved therapy can make a difference for people with multiple sclerosis. Learn about your options by talking to your health care professional and contacting the National MS Society at nmss.org or 1-800-344-4867 (1-800-FIGHT-MS).
